

## **September 2007 | Teenage Cancer Trust Fashion Show, Edinburgh**

As many of you will know, when some people undergo chemotherapy, they lose their hair. That's tough to cope with at any age but especially so as a teenager. Our goal is to make that journey easier and more pleasurable too. We aim, in the first instance, to raise £10,000 by 31 December 2007. This will fund publishing a leaflet or booklet, written mainly by teenagers who have lost their hair and who really understand what happens. We will also provide real hair wigs to teenagers - these wigs are much more natural than the acrylic wigs and can be fashioned to suit different moods for different days! And finally, we plan to provide an aftercare service.

This will also be an opportunity to see Danit Levi, top fashion stylist in action as she chooses clothes from the latest Mexx range to suit our volunteer models. Wine and canapés will be served, courtesy of Mexx and of course there's one of Lynne's famous raffles!
